*You must <u>make an appointment using our online booking system</u> before submitting the application to Central Registration.

- Student selection for the Late French Immersion program is determined by lottery in a manner that is consistent with <u>Policy 605</u>: <u>Admission of Students to School</u>.
- All programs are based on sufficient enrolment.
