

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## **Guiding Principles**

- Courses must be aligned with the Ministry of Education's "Know-Do-Understand" curriculum design
- Courses may not overlap with current course content in a significant way, or be remedial or modified versions
- Courses can count towards elective credits (Grades 10-12)
  in the Graduation Program, but NOT as targeted credit
  (e.g.: Social Studies 11/12 credit)
- Courses may not be used toward the Adult Graduation Program



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## **History**

2018 BC'S New Curriculum - all BAA Courses reviewed

2020 Disruption

2024 February - Audit - School level BAA

**April/May** – Comprehensive Review (retire, revise, no action)

**July-October** – Summer/Fall writes of draft Frameworks.

October-December – Joint Committee Process and Revisions

November – Board Meeting, information and feedback

December - Board Meeting, 9 courses for approval

**2025** January – Board Presentation 4 courses for approval

February - Joint Committee to create annual review cycle nysd
