
The Great Re-Wiring of Childhood

Phone based vs Play-Based Childhood

- Social patterns, role models, emotions, physical activity, and even sleep patterns have been **fundamentally recast**...only since 2012...
- Screen time for ages 8-12 is now five hours and thirty-three minutes a day
- Screen time for teens 13-18 is up to eight hours and thirty-eight minutes a day
- Humans are **social beings that thrive on connection**... a play-based childhood strengthens... a phone-based **Childhood weakens them.**

Devices off, learning on! New guidelines introduced for the use of Personal

Digital Devices (PDD) across the school district.

- Provincial Directive received April 12, 2024.
- Letters to families were issued through the Superintendent's Office (June 21 and August 22, 2024).
- School administrators were briefed on the changes and associated expectations at school district-level meetings August 20 and August 27, 2024. Janis Mann, District Principal, Inclusive Education, explained the exceptions related to IEPs.
- Families received direct communication from the school principal reiterating the new guidelines and expectations at the end of August.
- Families received an update on PDD in the Superintendent's Report to the NVSD community issued September 19, 2024.
- Families will receive direct communication from the school principal regarding 'how things are going' by the end of September.
