Student Learning Survey

The Provincial Student Learning Survey is an annual survey of grades 4, 7, 10, 11, and 12 students, parents, and staff. It is unique in its scope, size and usefulness to schools as it gathers information on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and provincial perspective. Students have had an opportunity to complete this survey in their classes in the last three weeks.

As a parent of a grade 10, 11 or 12 student, you are also encouraged to participate in this survey, as your feedback is important in identifying and celebrating current strengths, as well as determining where the school needs to focus improvement. The surveys contain standard questions for the province.

To complete the survey, go to: http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat_survey. Any computer or phone with an Internet connection can be used, and access to the e-survey is simple and secure. The survey can be accessed by selecting the school district and school name where your child attends school. Provincial, District and School Reports for previous years can be viewed at the same site under the Results section. The e-survey site will be open until May 2nd, 2024.
