Re: 2024-2025 Schedule - X blocks and Careers 10

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope this letter finds you well. As a follow up letter to our previous communication regarding X-blocks for the 2024/25 school year, we would like to provide you with some additional details. X-block classes adhere to the day 1 or day 2 schedule and take place from 7:15am to 8:25am. Students enrolled in an X-block morning class will receive a study block in their timetable.

We are working on next year's timetable and can confirm the following X-block classes will be offered:

- Art metal 10, 11, 12 – Mr. Edgar
- English New Media 10 – Ms. Thomas
- Food Studies 11/12 – Ms. Avefjall
- Science 10 – Mr. Cheng
- Woodwork 10, 11, 12 – Mr. Riml

If your child has already emailed their counsellor and signed up for one of these courses, they will be automatically enrolled. Should your child wish to sign up for one of these courses, please have them email their grade counsellor and include a parent/guardian on the email. We thank all students who have expressed interest in participating in an X-block.

Please note that these new x-blocks are in addition to the music and drama classes that have traditionally been scheduled outside the regular timetable.

Career Life Education 10

For the 2024-2025, all grade 10 students will be enrolled in CLE 10 Blended. While most students have already opted for the blended class, this represents a shift for those who initially signed up for a face-to-face class. Due to space limitations and the success experienced with our blended model, we have decided to transition fully to the blended format. The course, taught by Argyle teachers, will be primarily online through Teams, with in-person classes scheduled during flex at various points throughout the year. Students will also have the



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opportunity to meet with their teacher in person during flex at Argyle. Students enrolled in CLE 10 through North Van Online Learning will not be enrolled in Argyle's blended CLE 10.
