

1. Final Report Cards

Report cards were published yesterday. Please ensure you download and save a copy of your child's report cards prior to July 31st as report cards disappear at year-end rollover. This final report card will contain all courses and marks for the year. Your child also has access to their report card through their MyEd account. If there are any questions or concerns about your child's report card please contact teachers by email directly prior to June 28th.

Students will need their Personal Education Number (PEN) which is a 9-digit number located at the top of their report card to access the Student Transcript Site. Completed grade 10 to 12 courses show on student Ministry transcripts.
