

Study Block Application 2024 - 2025

Criteria

Applications will be considered for students meeting ALL of the following criteria:

- You will be a grade 10, 11 or 12 student in the 2024-2025 school year, planning to take less than 8 courses total (including CLC 12 / X block courses)
- You are not a PEAK PERFORMANCE applicant (PEAK blocks are assigned from PEAK applications)
- You have a <u>demanding</u> course load and a study will allow you to complete work for your classes.
- You have an impeccable record of attendance with no unexcused absences.
- You have an excellent record of citizenship and have demonstrated the ability to work independently.

Responsibilities

A study block is a privilege and comes with responsibilities. If a study period is granted:

- During your study period you are expected to be using the time productively working on course work. As there is no direct supervision, Grade 10/11/12 students may remain on site. Students who do not use their study productively will be asked to leave campus. Suitable study spaces are:
 - a. In the Library with specific permission from the librarian.
 - b. In a classroom, collaborative space or break-out room with a teacher's permission.
 - c. In the Multipurpose Room (cafeteria or upper landing).
 - d. Off campus either at home or other suitable learning space.
- 2. In the event of an emergency (evacuation, fire, etc) students on studies report directly to office staff at the teacher reporting station (near garbage bins).
- 3. Students who do not use their study appropriately may have their study revoked and an additional class scheduled. In the event of a study being revoked, a student would need to join a class already in session; it would be a student's responsibility to catch up on all the missed work.
- 4. The Study Period does not provide credits towards graduation. It is the student's responsibility to determine how a study block will impact graduation status and post-secondary choices.
- 5. Students on studies do not have access to fitness facilities including the weight room, dance studio and gymnasiums.

Application Process

- 1. Write a formal statement, indicating why you need to have this time, and how you plan to use your study to improve your achievement.
- 2. Read and agree to the Responsibilities listed above.
- 3. Complete the section below.
- 4. Hand in your application along WITH your course selection form.
- 5. Application deadline is April 12th for the 2024-2025 school year.
