# Friday, November 1st - IB Diploma Grade 12

### Monday, November 4th - GRADE 12

Grade 12 students will be completing their assessment on Tuesday, November 4th.

There will be no regular classes for the day for all Grade 12 students (except IB Diploma students).

Students will be completing their assessments either in the morning or afternoon sessions. Please refer to the table below for the time assigned based on the first letter of your last name. Location details will be shared closer to the date. Please note the change in arrival time. Also, if possible, avoid bringing a bag to the assessment.

## Tuesday, November 5<sup>th</sup> - GRADE 10

The **Grade 10** Literacy Assessment is a provincial assessment that assesses student proficiency in literacy. It is a graduation requirement, and students take the assessment in their Grade 10 year.

Grade 10 students will be completing their assessment on Tuesday, November 5th. There will be no regular classes for the day for all Grade 10 students.

Students will be completing their assessments either in the morning or afternoon sessions. Please refer to the table below for the time assigned for you based on the first alphabet of your last name. Please note the change in arrival time. Locations details will be shared closer to the date. Also, if possible, avoid bringing a bag to the assessment.

### 3. Halloween Safety

# 4. Learning Conferences (formerly called parent teacher interviews)

Carson Graham's learning conferences are on Thursday, November 7th from 2pm to 4pm and 6pm to 8pm. Sessions are 5 minutes long. Information on how to sign up for learning conferences was emailed to parents & guardians and went live October 23rd. Students are welcome to attend with a parent/guardian.

The first booking window is from Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup> at 8am to Oct. 29<sup>th</sup> at 11:59am. In the first window parents are limited to 3 interviews per child.

On Wednesday, Oct. 30<sup>th</sup> at 8am a second booking window will open allowing parents to add up to 7 more interviews per child (if needed and still available). The second window will close on Wednesday, Nov. 6<sup>th</sup> at 8am.

### 5. Grade 12 Information - Grad photos




