New: Carson Graham is pleased to offer a Work Experience Co-Op for the 2025-26 school year for grade 11 and 12 students. The Co-Op program will offer students an opportunity to be in the workplace one day and at school for the other day. Students in the Co-Op are interested in entering the workforce after school, or a post-secondary program in trades or other professions. Students will achieve 12 credits toward their graduation by completing two work experience placements and Career Life Connections (CLC).

The Work Experience course is still offered, and students may take this course to explore many areas of employment.


