We are proud to offer the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (DP). The DP is an internationally recognized, **university preparatory program** that is widely acknowledged as the most prestigious high school diploma available to students. The DP curriculum is rigorous; it requires that students complete a **two-year program in grades 11 and 12.**

Free Parent Webinar - Substance Use Prevention: Mental Health and Decision-Making

The Ministry of Education and Child Care, in partnership with adolescent clinical psychologist **Dr. Hayley Watson** from <u>Open Parachute</u>, will host three, free virtual sessions for parents, guardians and caregivers that will focus on practical skills you can teach your child and youth (ages 0-19) to prevent substance use and mental health needs.
