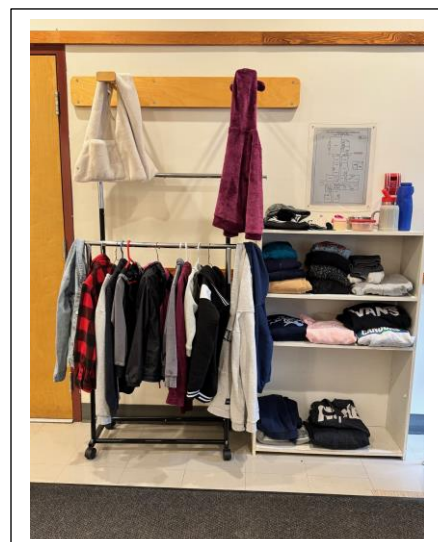

2025/26 Elementary Band and Strings - Registration Now open



Registration for the optional 2025/26 Elementary Band and Strings program is now open. Registration and payment is available as an option on School Cash Online.

Band is offered at Cove Cliff and is a popular program. It is held twice a week at Cove Cliff for participating students in grade 5 (beginning band) & grade 6-7 (continuing band). Most of the students continue with band into high school. The Strings program is offered for grade 4-7 students at Dorothy Lynas and Sherwood Park (Cove Cliff students can join but need to have transportation to and from the school).

There are two registration options and fees for 2025/26:

- Registration between January 13 - February 28, 2025– the fee is **\$550** and can be paid through a monthly instalment plan that will be in place until September 1st.
- Registration between March 14 - September 29, 2025 (Late Registration*) – the fee will be **\$625**. No monthly instalment plan is available for this option.
