Good afternoon Grade 8 Families,

Thank you all so very much for supporting us through an awesome school start up for our grade 8s. It was a pleasure meeting many of you at last week's Grade 8 parent meeting. We have the majority of our grade 8 forms in and are in the very final stages of organizing for the Grade 8 Retreat. If you have not submitted the Cheakamus Informed Consent, please do so ASAP. I am including some information in this letter that will be helpful for you to know, especially as we prepare to rotate 300 people up and down from the Cheakamus Centre on Sept 25th and 26th.

RETREAT DATES

If your student's last name is between **Akester - Leon Calderon** they will be at the Cheakamus Centre on Wednesday September 25th and at Handsworth on Thursday September 26th

If your student's last name is between **Levental – Zirnhelt** they will be at Handsworth on Wednesday September 25th and the Cheakamus Centre on Thursday September 26th.

A reminder that departure for the Cheakamus Centre is at **7:30am** with a **4:30ish** expected return time. The Handsworth day will start at **8:45am** and end at **3:00pm**.
