FORMAT when reporting an absence:

- ✓ First name of student
- ✓ Last name of student
- ✓ Grade
- Date of absence (whole day or state the portion of the day)
- Explanation for absence ("excused", "ill", "appointment", "vacation")
- ✓ Your name & relation to the student. (Only emails from parents and legal guardians are accepted.)




