



Tiers of Support (fluid)



- Referrals
- Psych-ed/other assessments
- Referral to LC or Choices
- Additional supports

Targeted

- Teaching to Diversity Checklist
- Supported by LST/Counsellor
- Short-term individual/small group instruction and skill building
- Behavioural observation & data collection

Universal

- Service in regular class
- Class review/profile
- UDL
- Trauma informed practice/ PBS

Accessing Support @ Handsworth

Drop-in Support

self regulation, working on assignments

Tutorial

Daily in mornings - all teachers available

Support block

Targeted supports for academic, self regulation, executive functioning, scheduled test writing

Teaching to Diversity Checklists

- Sent to teachers early in the year
- Usually managed by grade counsellor
- Updated with students, shared with parents

Inclusive Education Plans (IEPs)

- Carry forward with the student
- Teachers can view before start of classes
- Renewed throughout Fall
- In most cases, IEP meetings held with students first, then sent to parents for consultation

Referrals for Support

For September

 By grade 7 teachers/ support teams

Throughout the year

- Classroom teachers/Case Manager/ Counsellor will reach out
- School-Based Resource Team

Counselling

Provide voluntary, confidential (even from parents) counselling to students (limitations to confidentiality)

Help students develop insight and coping strategies/skills for stress, anxiety, depression, and other mental health challenges

Connect students to community resources

Support problem-solving with peers, family, and/or classroom difficulties

Academic advising and basic post-secondary/career guidance

Learning Assistance Centre (LAC)



Targeted support for literacy, numeracy, organization



Students have a Ministry identification or Teaching to Diversity Checklist



Can be accessed through a support block and/or in tutorial and/or throughout the day



Support from LSTs, EAs

Provides a calm, safe space

Focus on Social-Emotional needs

Students may have Ministry Identification

Support from Teacher, Counsellor, YEW, EA

Choices

Youth Engagement Worker (YEW)

Check in with students

Monitor progress in all class

Foster student connection to the building

Build 1:1 connections with students

Assist in Choices before school, in tutorial, at lunch

Targeted 1:1 instruction




What helped in my academic life
