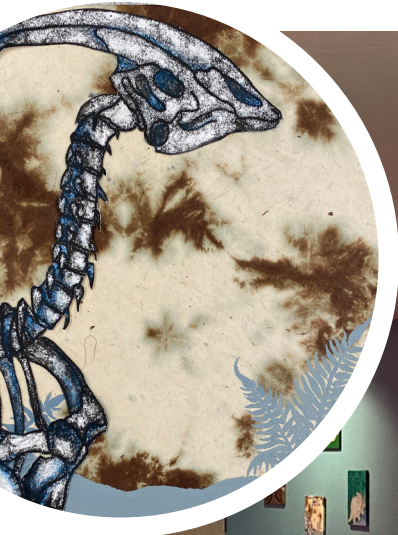


MONSTERS OF THE ABYSS STUDENT EXHIBITION

THE COMBINATION OF GENERATIVE DRAWINGS, TRACE MONOTYPES, AND ACRYLIC PAINTING ON DECORATIVE PAPERS LED TO A PROFESSIONAL COLLECTION OF WORKS THAT NOT ONLY REFLECT THE STRENGTHS OF THESE ARTISTS, BUT ALSO THE DESIGN SENSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITION AT THE VANCOUVER AQUARIUM.
