## Dear Parents/Guardians:

On the afternoon of Thursday June 13<sup>th</sup>, the staff and students of Queen Mary Community Elementary will participate in an earthquake and student release drill. This will give us an opportunity to practice and assess an important part of our school's emergency preparedness plan.

## **WHAT WILL TAKE PLACE:**

Following an earthquake drill, we will begin a controlled student release. Parents/guardians or the adult <u>approved as your alternate for pick-up</u> (as listed on the Student Release Form submitted to the school earlier this year) are asked to come to the school Reception Centre, which will be the gym, <u>after 1:15 p.m.</u> to pick up your child/children. Please enter through the gym WEST doors (by the basketball court) and follow posted signs and instructions provided by staff members. All other entrance doors will be locked and there will be no access to the rest of the school.

## PLEASE NOTE:

- You do <u>not</u> need to take time off work to participate in this drill. We encourage as many parents/designated alternates to participate as possible, to assist us in truly assessing our procedures so we can learn about how to improve our process, *BUT participation is not a requirement, so please <u>do NOT take any time off work to participate!</u>*
- If you are not available to come to the school to pick up your child/children, we encourage you to contact one of the <u>designated alternates</u> that you have listed on your <u>Emergency Student</u> <u>Release Form</u> (MUST be 19+ years of age) to discuss with them the option of taking part in this drill.
- Bring photo ID with you (valid BC Driver's License or passport).
  - Photo ID will be required, as proof of identification, for ALL adults, even if we know you
    well! Please do not be offended by this it is just part of practicing the appropriate
    process! We can ONLY release children into the care of their own parent/guardian OR
    adult listed on the *Emergency Student Release Form*, <u>confirmed with photo ID.</u>
  - Once inside the gym you will be asked to go to a check-in table. At the table you will be asked by school personnel to verify who you are by showing valid PHOTO ID, even if the person asking you knows you well!
- PLEASE exercise calm and patience during this process. Students will be released through a formal process. Expect wait time!
- Please respect the importance of controlling the release of students. Student SAFETY is the priority.
- PLEASE take children immediately home with you, as there will be NO supervision on the school grounds. Leaving school grounds immediately would be what you would do in a real emergency student release situation. Students/Adults will not be allowed back into the school.
- All students not picked up during the afternoon will be dismissed shortly after 3:00 p.m.
