Halloween is Thursday, October 31st!

On **Thursday October 31**st, **Halloween Day**, we invite students to wear costumes to school.

Please abide by the following costume expectations as stated in the attached letter from our NVSD Superintendent:

- Costumes should allow for students to be easily recognizable; no masks or face coverings please! (consider using face paints instead)
- Costumes must be appropriate for school setting and for all ages
- Replica weapons (e.g., guns, knives, swords etc.) are not allowed

QM Primary classes will be doing a **costume parade** outside starting at 9:15 a.m. during which time the choir will also perform. Parents/Guardians and younger siblings are welcome to join us outside to watch this entertaining parade! The Primary costume parade will then leave the grounds and travel to a senior's center in our community, returning to the school by recess.

PLEASE help keep our school community safe on Halloween.

Fireworks and firecrackers are not allowed on school property. There are also strict requirements for use of any fireworks in the community (permits required). Visit the City of North Vancouver and District of North Vancouver websites for information on municipal fireworks regulations.

PLEASE immediately report any suspicious activity seen on our school grounds (potential for vandalism), or fireworks being let off on our school property, to the RCMP by calling the non-emergency line: 604-985-1311.
