Pick-Up and Drop-Off Safety

We want to take a moment to remind everyone of the importance of safety during pick-up and drop-off times. Ensuring a safe environment for all our students is our top priority. Please follow all posted signage and observe school safety and posted signage rules during these busy times. Here are a few key guidelines to keep in mind:

- Use designated drop-off and pick-up zones only: Be quick if you are using the designated drop-off area near the playground. Please avoid double parking, using areas marked for staff parking, or no stopping/no parking signs. Please do not stop in front of neighbours' houses and block their driveways.
- **Be mindful of crossing areas**: Remind your child to use crosswalks, and please watch for pedestrians, especially in front of the school.
- Follow speed limits: Drive slowly and attentively in school zones.
- **No U-turns in front of the school**: This can create unexpected hazards for both pedestrians and other drivers.

Following these rules helps create a safe and respectful environment for everyone. Thank you for your cooperation and for setting an example for our students.
