Please check your assigned locker and make sure the information above is correct. The lock belongs to the locker; do not change it. **Do not switch lockers!** For safety reasons we must be able to get into all lockers, so we need to have the correct information at all times. The only time the lock is changed is when there is a problem with the lock (see office) or when a student leaves the school.

- Pull shackle open
- To close span shackle in lock
