





Student Transcript Services

- Go to Ministry of Education (MOE) transcript services website: <u>http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca</u>
- 2. You will need your Personal Education Number (PEN) PEN can be found on your report card or see your counsellor
- 3. Register for a BCeID follow the prompts
- 4. email will be sent to you to activate your registration
- Click on the link to verify your identity: "Activate Student Transcripts Registration"



Send transcripts to PSI's...

 Once you have set up your BCeID account, go to: <u>http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca</u> (you'll need your username & password)



- 2. On "My Dashboard" you can see various selections. Choose "Send/Order Transcript"
- 3. You must check the consent box
- 4. Select "Send your transcript to a university, college, or other post-secondary institution"
- 5. You can select up to 25 PSI's to send your transcript to...they are listed alphabetically. You can also change the province & search international institutions
- Choose "Send" option for each PSI you selected (most students select: "Send interim and final marks when they are available") Interim marks are sent electronically in May and final marks are sent in July
- 7. Carefully check your PSI selections then confirm & click "Add to Cart"

Broad Based Admission...

- Many PSI's (like UBC) looking for well-rounded students – holistic view
- Admissions based on personal profile rather than just GPA
- Looking at extra-curriculars, volunteering, leadership, work experience, overcoming challenges, etc.
- Not just listing achievements/experiences but <u>REFLECTING</u> on the learning that has come out of them, how they've shaped you, what you've learned about yourself, impact on future goals, etc. https://you.ubc.ca/applying-ubc/how-to-apply/personalprofile/

Stay organized...

- Digital file or binder keep track of all applications, student #, logins, etc.
- Monitor accounts for what is required...transcripts, supplemental docs, etc. & upcoming deadlines

General pointers on preparing scholarship applications.



Reference Letters...

- References letters often required for PSI applications & scholarship/bursary applications
- Which teacher/counsellor knows you best?
- Give lots of lead time...2 weeks preferred!
- Provide information for your reference: Scholarship Reference form available on MS Teams - Grade 12 team and Scholarship team or paper copy from your counsellor

Local Scholarships

- Applications available December 2024
- Applications due January (TBA) 2025
