Student Transcript Services

1. Go to Ministry of Education (MOE) transcript services website:
<http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca>
2. You will need your Personal Education Number (PEN)
PEN can be found on your report card or see your counsellor
3. Register for a BCeID – follow the prompts
4. email will be sent to you to activate your registration
5. Click on the link to verify your identity:
“Activate Student Transcripts Registration”

Send transcripts to PSI's...



1. Once you have set up your BCeID account, go to:
<http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca>
(you'll need your username & password)
2. On "My Dashboard" you can see various selections. Choose "Send/Order Transcript"
3. You must check the consent box
4. Select "Send your transcript to a university, college, or other post-secondary institution"
5. You can select up to 25 PSI's to send your transcript to...they are listed alphabetically. You can also change the province & search international institutions
6. Choose "Send" option for each PSI you selected (most students select: "Send interim and final marks when they are available") Interim marks are sent electronically in May and final marks are sent in July
7. Carefully check your PSI selections then confirm & click "Add to Cart"

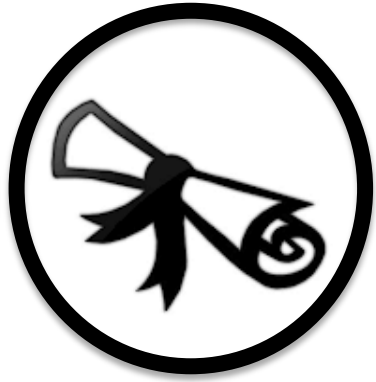

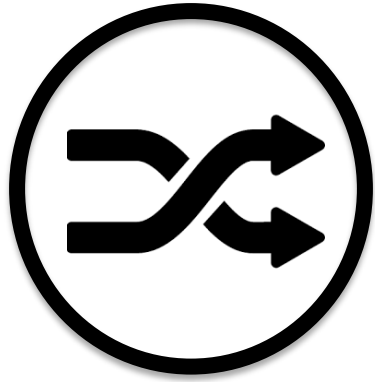

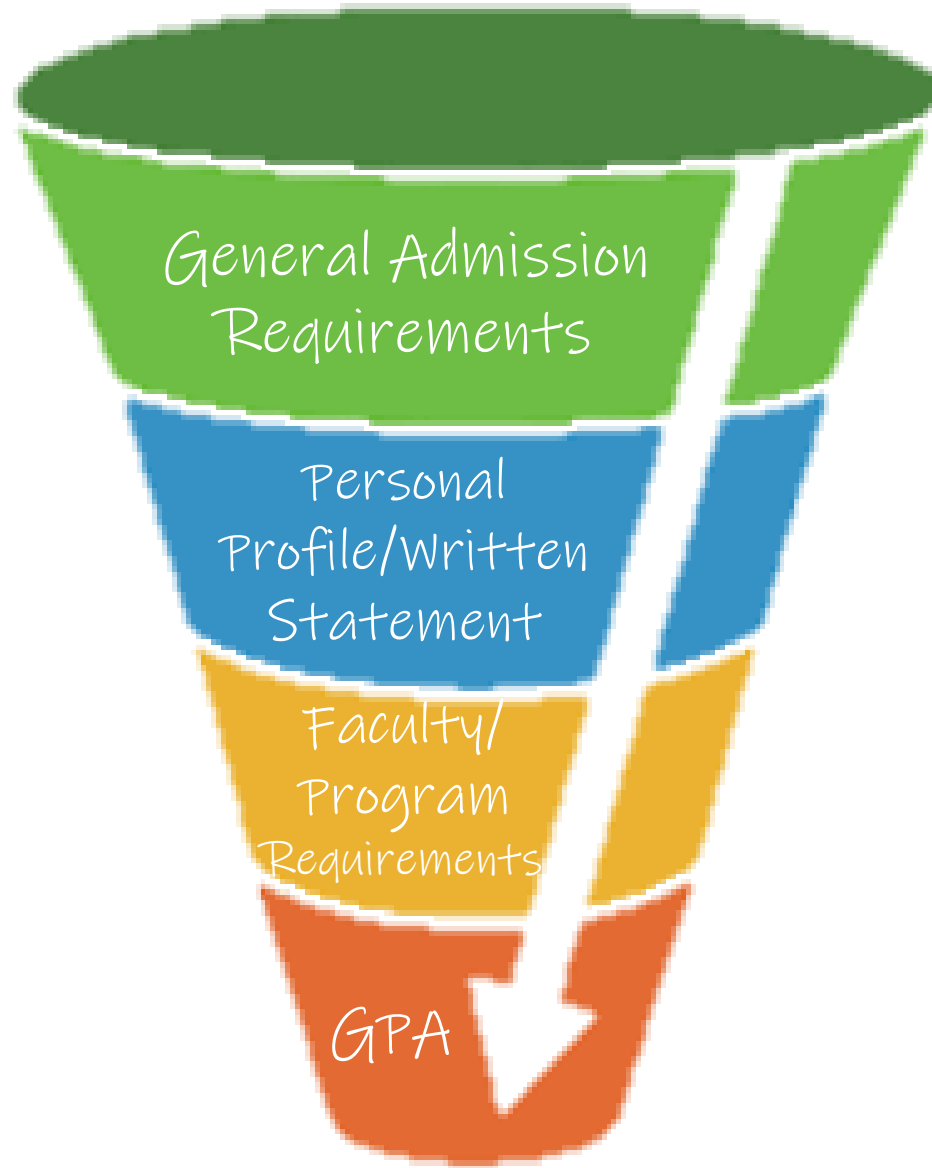

Broad Based Admission...



- Many PSI's (like UBC) looking for well-rounded students – holistic view
- Admissions based on personal profile rather than just GPA
- Looking at extra-curriculars, volunteering, leadership, work experience, overcoming challenges, etc.
- Not just listing achievements/experiences but **REFLECTING** on the learning that has come out of them, how they've shaped you, what you've learned about yourself, impact on future goals, etc. <https://you.ubc.ca/applying-ubc/how-to-apply/personal-profile/>

Stay organized...

- Digital file or binder – keep track of all applications, student #, logins, etc.
- Monitor accounts for what is required...transcripts, supplemental docs, etc. & upcoming deadlines

SCHOLARSHIP CHECK-LIST

- Create a post-secondary scholarship folder
- Prepare a scholarship resume
- Develop a bank of life experiences and related strengths, growth, learning, and reflections
- Research available scholarships **for which I am eligible**
- Check for parental affiliation with unions, club, company, etc.
- Create a spreadsheet/list of scholarships for which I am applying
- Check deadlines of those scholarships
- Ask for and receive letters of reference
- Request transcripts
- Apply for my SIN

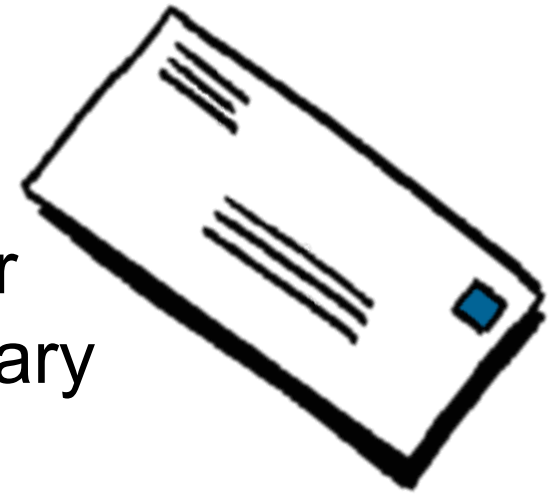

- Give lots of lead time...2 weeks preferred!
- Provide information for your reference:
Scholarship Reference form available on MS Teams - Grade 12 team and Scholarship team
or paper copy from your counsellor
