For today's Women Wednesday we are recognizing Malala Yousafzai.

Malala was born in Mingora, Pakistan on July 12th, 1997. She attended an all-girl school in her village where her father taught classes but in 2008 the Taliban took control of her town and banned many things like watching tv, listening to music, and the ability of girls going to school. Malala spoke openly for girls' rights to learn and in 2012 she was a victim of an act of violence.

After much time recovering Malala and her family moved to the UK where she started the Malala fund, fighting for every girl to achieve a future she chooses. In 2014 Malala was the youngest ever Nobel laureate. She then began studies in philosophy, and politics at the University of Oxford in 2018, and continues to travel the world and help girls and women fighting poverty, wars, child marriage and gender discrimination for the ability to go to school through the Malala fund. What an inspiration!
