I have REALLY enjoyed my time as PAC chair and co-chair. It has been a privilege to represent the parent community with an amazing team, as we support students and staff at Upper Lynn. ULE consists of positive and generous families who simultaneously know how to have fun and care deeply about important issues.

However, I need to step down to increase my paid-work hours and finish my master's degree.

This means that the PAC chair roles are up for the taking, it can be a team effort as much of the position can be delegated, but only two people can have official voting roles.



As previously mentioned, the ULE PAC is at risk of not existing next year unless one or two new people step into the roles of PAC CHAIR/CO-CHAIR. We have until TUESDAY JUNE 11th.

And just incase you're curious about what the PAC does ... this graphic is a rough breakdown of the money that comes in through the PAC. (\$56,000 divided by 500 children is approximately \$112 each). If there is no PAC, we lose over \$55,000 for the school.

- 2. We sheepishly ask every parent to donate \$112/child to the school.
