Reminders

School Supplies

This year, we are transitioning to a bulk purchasing system for school supplies. Families will be asked to pay a fee of \$78 per student, with a reduced fee of \$50 for kindergarten students. Additionally, there will be a cost of \$8 for next year's planner. Our goal with this new approach is to lower the cost of supplies over time as classrooms build a baseline of resources.

By having the school handle the purchasing of supplies, we aim to achieve several benefits:

- 1. **Cost Savings:** Buying in bulk allows us to take advantage of lower prices, which helps reduce the overall cost of supplies.
- 2. **Consistency in Resources**: All students will have access to the same high-quality materials, ensuring a uniform learning experience.

- 3. **Reduced Stress for Families**: Parents and families will no longer need to worry about shopping for specific items, making the back-to-school process smoother and less stressful.
- 4. **Minimized Waste**: This method helps cut down on unnecessary waste, as we can better manage the quantities of supplies needed, reducing leftover materials at the end of the school year.

We believe this change will not only benefit our students and their families but also support a more efficient and sustainable approach to resource management in our classrooms.
