World Teacher Day

World Teachers' Day, observed on October 5th annually, globally celebrates and honors teachers for their hard work, dedication, and contributions to society. It's a time for expressing gratitude and emphasizing quality education. World Teachers' Day encourages students, parents, and communities to appreciate and support educators who play a pivotal role in nurturing students' intellectual and social growth.

Foundational Skills Assessment (Grades 4 & 7)

Upper Lynn's grade 4 and grade 7 students will be writing the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) starting October 1st. The FSA is a set of reading, writing, and numeracy assessments administered to BC students every year in Grades 4 and 7. Like previous years, the testing is occurring in October rather than February to allow schools time to utilize the student's assessment results to better plan for instruction. The FSA aligns with BC's curriculum and can be used to support classroom-based decision-making for student learning.

Reminder: Send Extra Clothes and Rain Gear!

As the rainy season approaches, please remember to send your child(ren) to school with extra clothes and appropriate rain gear, such as raincoats and boots. Our students go outside for recess and lunch, rain or shine, so it's important they are dressed to stay warm and dry. Having extra clothes at school ensures your child can change if they get wet during outdoor activities. Thank you for helping us keep everyone comfortable and ready to learn!

Drills

Throughout the school year, schools routinely carry out emergency drills, which include procedures for fire, earthquake, and lockdown situations. In the upcoming weeks, all North Vancouver Schools will be conducting a lockdown drill, with ours scheduled for Tuesday October 8th at 10:10 AM.

We kindly request that during this drill, you refrain from visiting the school as all entry points will be secured. Lockdown drills serve various purposes, including addressing scenarios such as the presence of an animal on the school grounds or an unwelcome visitor on the premises.
