FSA Results Going Home This Week – Grade 4 & 7 Families

This week, Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) results will be sent home with Grade 4 and 7 students. The FSA, completed in October and November 2024, provides a snapshot of your child's literacy and numeracy skills based on provincial standards. These results are not factored into classroom assessments but serve as one of many tools to support student learning. The assessments were scored using BC Performance Standards, with written responses evaluated by trained educators in our district.
