Kilometre Club

Upper Lynn's Kilometre Club will begin on Tuesday April 1st and will run until June. This club is open to all students from Kindergarten to Grade 3. Students will add kilometres with their class and may walk or jog at their own pace – no stopping except when a lap is completed! Students may not claim more than 3 kilometres (9 laps) per day. Remember: 3 laps = 1 kilometre. Students will need to have runners at school every day. Jog safely, and have fun!
